Dear Minister,

### **71.43% increase in licensing transaction fees set for 1 February 2018**

1. We refer to the abovementioned matter and confirm that we have not received any response from you to our letter dated 16 October 2017.
2. Notwithstanding the foregoing, we have noted your written responses to the Parliamentary questions posed by the Honourable Mr WM Madisha of COPE in October 2017 and Mr MS De Freitas of the DA in December 2017.
3. We acknowledge that the RTMC Act and its Regulations does not require of the Minister of Transport to publish the proposed vehicle licensing transaction fee increase for democratic participation and comment. However, notwithstanding



- your explanation therefor, it is somewhat disturbing to note that the increase in such transaction fees you have prescribed with effect from 1 February 2018 equates to a 71.43% increase therein.
4. On 3 November 2017, after repeatedly being asked what JPSA was doing about this increase, we published an online petition on our website at <https://www.jp-sa.org/71increase/> for those who felt strongly aggrieved by this increase to electronically put their names to. As part of the signing process associated therewith, we required signatories to confirm their email address details, thereby actively discouraging arbitrary and/or duplicate signatories.
  5. Although we received more than 3,500 signatures by the time we closed the petition on 7 January 2018, not all of them complied with the confirmation processes and therefore, those signatories were not counted. We attach hereto a list of the 2,360 unique signatories who did comply with the confirmation process we put in place.
  6. Whilst we realise that 2,360 unique signatories pales in comparison to the registered vehicle and driving licence holders population registered on eNaTIS, it must not be forgotten that this petition only ran for a short time, much of which was during the December festive season, and our ability to make everyone aware of its existence was extremely limited. Nevertheless, we have little doubt that, unless you rescind your decision, when people go to renew their vehicle licence discs from 1 February 2018 onwards, they will notice this hike and will have quite a lot to say about it.
  7. We therefore urge you to reconsider your decision and consider the possibility of prescribing a more reasonable increase in this fee.

## **Petition**

**To: The Minister of Transport, the Honourable Mr MJ Maswanganyi, MP**

We, the undersigned, being owners of motor vehicles registered in the Republic of South Africa who are compelled in terms of the National Road Traffic Act and its Regulations to licence our motor vehicles and pay fees on an annual basis, hereby register our objection to the administrative decision taken by the Minister of Transport, the Honourable Mr MJ Maswanganyi, MP to increase the transaction fee payable to the Road Traffic Management Corporation on vehicle licensing transactions by 71.43%, with effect from 1 February 2018.

We hereby demand that the Minister rescinds his decision and, if any increase whatsoever in such transaction fee is considered to be warranted, that such increase be brought in line with the inflation rate determined by the CPI, and limits it to no more than a five percent (5%) increase.
